### INSTRUCTIONS:

- All times are when student athletes need to be at their assigned fields and prepared to shoot. After the starting time, all starting and completion times are estimated.
- Coaches will affix pre-printed labels (supplied at the coach check-in) containing the athlete information on the supplied scoring sheet to form a squad at the field.
- Please use the corresponding labels for each Session (1 and 2).
- All athletes will shoot 50 targets in each Session.
- Squads for Session 2 must be comprised of the same athletes and squad sequence as Session 1.
- It is important to be prepared to shoot immediately after the previous squad completes their round.
- Numbers in parentheses (00) indicate shooter quantities.
- Squads with fewer than five shooters may be combined with other members from other teams to form complete squads of five.
- Teams should arrive and check-in at least one hour before scheduled shooting time.
- Coaches must check-in at the tent prior to first scheduled shooting time.
- Athletes must check-in with their team at their assigned field. They DO NOT need to check-in with tournament officials.
- No athlete registrations or substitutions are allowed.
